The **Proflex**® system comprises a high quality prefabricated 6mm rubber mat and specially formulated acrylic coatings resulting in an extremely durable impervious surface offering maximum comfort and consistent ball bounce.

As well as having excellent durability the cushioning effect will remain

constant throughout seasonal temperature variations and over many years of use.



The uniform thickness of the mat ensures true ball bounce on all areas of the court.

The coatings can be adjusted to meet the slip resistance requirements for other sports such as netball, basketball and five-a-side. This makes it the ideal surface choice for Multi Use Games Areas (**MUGAs**).



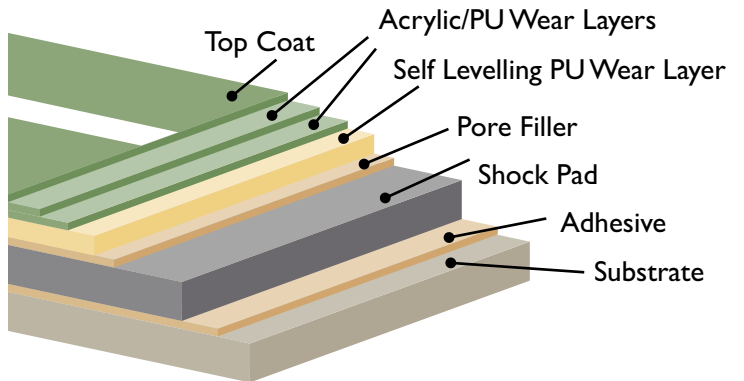
The cross section shows the key components in the **Proflex®** surface system.

The substrate is usually a high density macadam or concrete base with minimum thickness as laid down by the SAPCA Code of Practice for the Construction and Maintenance of Tennis Courts.

The recycled rubber mat is then adhered to the substrate using a specially formulated solvent free adhesive.

A unique water-based single pack acrylic is applied as a pore filler resulting in a smooth surface for the final two layers of highly durable acrylic coating that are pigmented and textured providing the required slip resistance and choice of colour.
